Dear Friends.

In the summer of 2005, our son Zachary was diagnosed with a rare, life-threatening genetic disease known as Hunter Syndrome (MPS II) for which there is no cure. Making Precious Strides, Inc. was founded to create awareness and raise money to help find a cure for Hunter Syndrome.

Hunter Syndrome (Mucopolysaccharidosis II or MPS II) is an inherited disorder in which an enzyme, iduronate-2-sulfatase (I2S), is deficient. I2S is involved in the breakdown of complex carbohydrates called mucopolysaccharides. Without sufficient I2S in the body, partially brokendown mucopolysaccharides accumulate in various organs and tissues of the body leading to potentially life-threatening complications. This is a permanent medical condition.

Please help us find a cure for this devastating disease. Until recently, there was relatively little research into this rare condition. Progress will continue to be slow unless we gain the support of individuals like you who recognize the precious gift of promise and hope that lives within each child with Hunter Syndrome.

We are proud to announce that this year's event marks our fifth year anniversary. When we originally started Zach's Run, we did not expect the event to grow into the event that it is today with hundreds of participants coming out to show their support for Hunter Syndrome while raising over \$84,000 for research programs. In 2009, MPS, Inc. donated over \$20,000 to research hospitals.

EVENT DETAILS

The event will be held on Saturday, September 18, rain or shine, with registration beginning at 7:30 A.M. at Sixth Street and the Boardwalk in Ocean City, New Jersey.

The event consists of a 5K (3.1-mile) run and 1-mile fun walk open to all ages. The 5K race starts on the boardwalk, heading north on to the road route with the finish line on the track. Hunter Syndrome (Mucopolysaccharidosis II) is a lifethreatening, genetic disease that affects the body's ability to break down mucopolysaccharides in joints and soft tissue leading to life-long complications. Although the disease is uncommon, consider these startling facts:

FAST FACTS:

- At least 1 out of 162,000 children worldwide are affected by Hunter Syndrome
- A child affected by Hunter Syndrome may live into their 60's if their diagnosis is mild or, if they have severe Hunters, they may only reach the age of 15. However, regardless of their severity, their life will be altered dramatically.
- MPS II occurs in boys, and girls may be carriers of the gene for MPS II. Although rare, MPS II has been diagnosed in girls.
- There is an estimate in the United States that 1 in 25,000 births will result in some form of MPS.
